BOUNDARY UPDATE LETTERS

Over the Fall Break, EIPS sent all current students Kindergarten to Grade 8 residing the northeast quadrant letters about the new boundaries. These letters are to inform families how the new 2018-19 attendance boundaries may affect them.

Briefly, students residing in the Davidson Creek Elementary attendance area will be designated to this new school. Boundary exemptions will not apply. The exception is for "grandfathered" students entering grade 6. Students in grade 6 for the 18/19 school year may continue (finish) at their current elementary school. Students living in Lakeland Ridge will be designated to Lakeland Ridge School.
